The Problem and the Solution

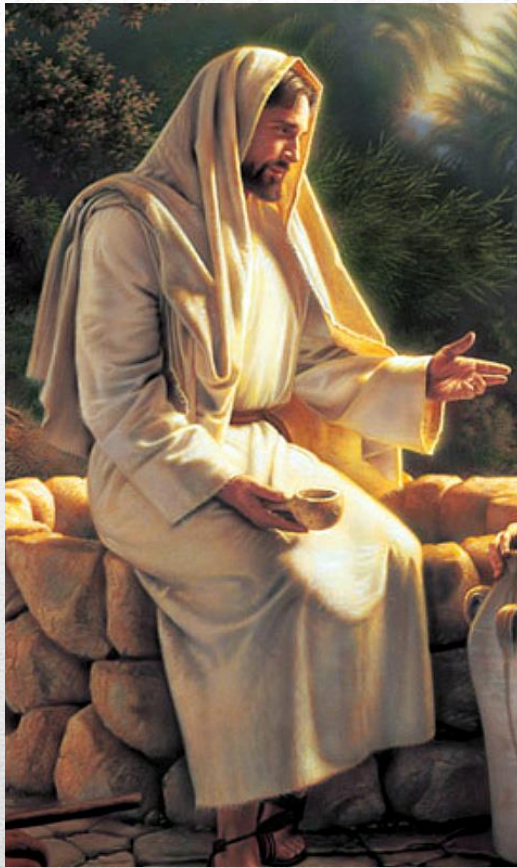

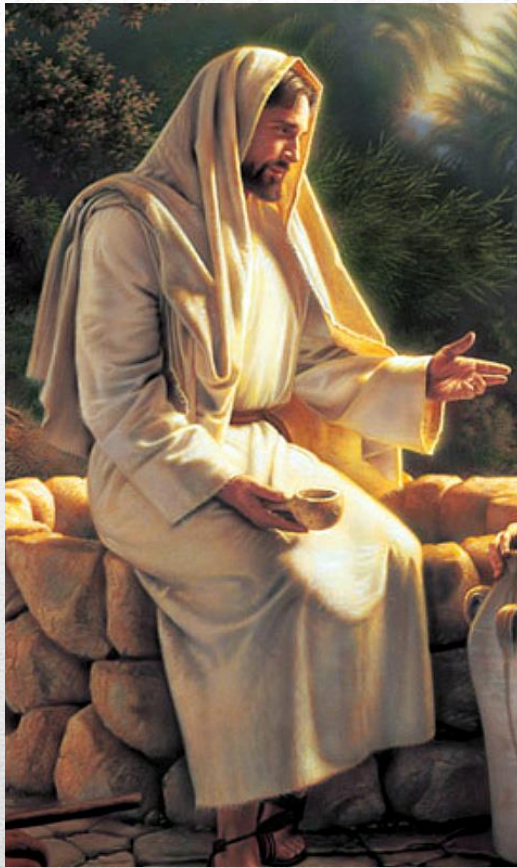
